Understanding the Need

ORGAN Donation- Life Saving Gift: Did you know more than **90,000** people wait anxiously for a chance at tomorrow, a second chance at life? Of these, approximately **67,275** await a kidney, 35% being African American. Another **3,109** await a new heart, **157** a heart/lung combination, **17,922** a liver, **3,381** lungs, **2,533** kidney/Pancreas combination, **187** intestines and **1,704** pancreatic transplants.

In 2004, there were **27,038** "life-saving" organ transplants performed in the United States; **20,047** from deceased donors and **6,691** from living donors. Though these numbers seem large, the waiting list grows by at least **10,000** every 12 months.

Facts: An estimated **10,000 to 14,000** people who die each year meet the criteria for Organ Donation, but less than half of those individuals become an actual Organ Donor.

In the average workday, **43.8** people will join the UNOS Organ Transplant waiting list and **5.9** people will die while waiting on this list.

TISSUE Donation – Life Enhancing and Life Saving Gift: In addition to organs, thousands of allograft surgeries are performed each year in the United States; aiding in the enhancement of life in patients who are suffering disabling defects. Nationally, over 1 million people are helped annually through tissue donation, while over **20,000** people donate tissue. Fact: As many as **100** people can be helped by one donor.

Donation of tissues for transplantation can include bone, heart for heart valves, skin, saphenous and femoral veins, tendons and Fascia. To maximize the gift, families may also consent for tissues to be

recovered for medical education and research, in the event the tissue is unsuitable for transplantation.

Regardless of the tissues needed, utilized by transplant surgeons or on-going research projects to help improve the health of our communities, the numbers of donations are not sufficient. Visit www.shareyourlife.org for more information.

OCULAR Donation – Life Enhancing Gift: The numbers grow even larger when the numbers of people waiting for corneal transplants are added to the equation. In 2001, the Eye Bank Association of America (EBAA) reported more than **10 million** people worldwide await a cornea to restore sight and their lives. In addition, an estimated **33,035** corneal transplants were performed in the United States and **100,000-200,000** worldwide. Visit www.restoresight.org for more information.

BLOOD (whole), Bone Marrow & Stem Cell, Apheresis and Cord Blood Donation: Each year 30,000 people are diagnosed with life-threatening diseases for which a **bone marrow or stem cell** transplant could be their only cure. Less than 5% of the eligible population donates **blood** in the US each year, but one in every 20 people will need a blood transfusion sometime in their life. **Apheresis** donation provides the same amount of platelets as eight whole blood donations and is crucial for leukemia and heart surgery patients. **Umbilical cord blood** offers another transplant option for people - especially children - diagnosed with leukemia, anemia's and other inherited disorders.

One person's gift is a miracle for many.

PUBLIC AWARENESS INITIATIVE: Through the efforts of the national and local chapter's of the Associates and Nurses Endorsing Transplantation (ANET), more people each day are becoming involved in increasing public awareness of the urgent need for Organ & Tissue donation.
